## **GPS301 SOFTWARE UPDATE PROCESS**

### **PC REQUIREMENTS FOR DOWNLOADING**

Computer :




- Pentium II equivalent or higher
- Operating System: Win 98 second edition, WIN2000 or XP
- Internet Connection
- Serial Port on the computer

Accessories:

- AC Adaptor (supplied with unit)
- Serial Cable (supplied with unit)

### **DOWNLOAD PROCEDURE**

#### **Preparation**

1. Connect the AC adaptor of your GPS301 to a power point and turn the AC adaptor on.
2. Connect the serial cable:
  - i. Plug the stereo connector of the serial cable into the serial port of your GPS301
  - ii. Plug the other end of the serial cable to the serial port of your computer
3. Turn on your GPS301 at the Volume Control
4. Press  MENU
5. Scroll  to "Options" and press  SELECT

6. Scroll  to “Download” and press  SELECT

The word “Connect” will now be displayed in the screen of the GPS301

### **Downloading Software**

7. Downloading the file (Uniden GPS Uploader.exe) enables GPS extraction software and the new data to be downloaded into your GPS301. Once you have read these complete instructions, please return to the GPS301 product page on the web site to commence Step B.

“Software Updates:

Step B. Commence the software and data download process (Step 7). Double click [here](#)”

After you have actioned Step B: The Uniden\_GPS\_Uploader.zip window will be displayed.

8. Click “Save”  
9. Save this file to your Desktop. Click “Save”  
10. Go to computer Desktop

### **Downloading New Data**

11. Double click the icon “Uniden\_GPS\_Uploader.zip” on your desktop.

(You will need to have WinZip extraction software. If you do not have this you can download an evaluation version at no cost.

Please go to: [www.winzip.com](http://www.winzip.com)

Click on WinZip in the Downloads section

Click on the Download the Evaluation icon.

Click Extract all files (2 files) to your Desktop\*)

\* Please be sure that you extract the 2 files (uploader ver1.00.ini and Uniden GPS Uploader.exe) using winzip otherwise the upload process to your GPS301 will not work

12. Double click “Uniden GPS Uploader.exe” on your desktop.

(If an error message is displayed when you double click on [here](#) (the Uniden GPS Uploader.exe) please:

- i. check the serial cable is connected
- ii. check that the PC is connected to the internet
- iii. check that the GPS301 has power and is switched on
- iv. check that the GPS301 is in the download mode and “Connect” is displayed)

Please note: If you have 'Marked' any of your own locations in your GPS301, these will not be overridden by this new data download process.

The following Uniden GPS Uploader Screen will appear:



Ensure the following options are shown:

- MODEL        GPS301
- Country      Australia and New Zealand
- Data Type    Camera
- File Name    (the latest data files will automatically appear here)

You can check to verify if the data available to download here is a more recent version than that currently installed in your GPS301. If the version number shown next to the

File Name window, for example, ver1.6 bin, is higher than that displayed next to the current data files: Data of GPS window, for example, Camera Data: ver 1.0 you should proceed to download this more recent data file.

13. Click “Execute”. This will update the GPS301 data. During downloading, a progress bar will be shown and data will be automatically stored in the GPS301.
  14. Once the uploading is complete – Click OK
  15. Then Exit
  16. Close the Uniden\_GPS\_Uploader.zip file by clicking the ‘X’ box.
  17. The new data files have automatically been downloaded into your GPS301. Please turn off the power to your GPS301 and return it to your vehicle. When the unit is next powered up it will operate with the new data.
